Population and Housing Fact Sheet

Johnstone Shire

Key Points

- The preliminary estimated resident population of Johnstone Shire at 30 June 2005 was 19,589 people, an increase of 36 people or 0.2 per cent over the year. This compares with an increase of 8 people in the year to June 2004.
- In the year to June 2005 natural increase (births minus deaths) accounted for an increase of 102 people while assumed net migration resulted in a loss of 66 people.
- Projections prepared by the Department indicate that by 2011 the expected population of Johnstone Shire will be between 19,500 and 19,900 people. By 2026 this is expected to change to between 19,300 and 20,900 people (Low and high series).
- The median age of Johnstone Shire's population is projected to increase by 11 years from a median age of 37 years in 2001 up to a median age of 48 years in 2026.
- Dwelling activity increased in Johnstone Shire in the year ending June 2006 with 99 approvals, 96.0 per cent of them for separate houses. Compared to 65 approvals in the previous year, these figures represent an increase of 52.3 per cent in dwelling activity.
