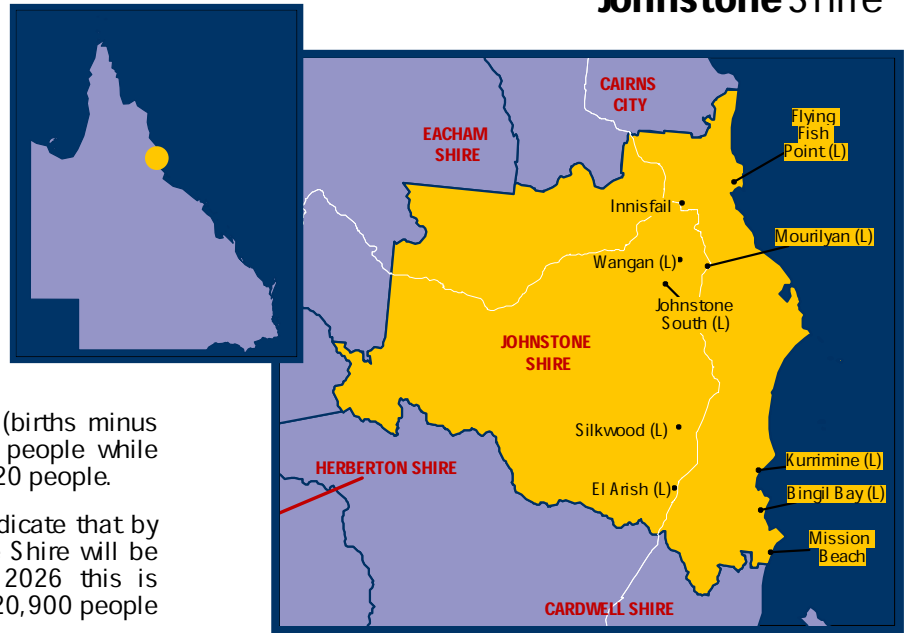


Johnstone Shire

Key Points

- The preliminary estimated resident population of Johnstone Shire at 30 June 2006 was 19,517 people, a decrease of 158 people or 0.8 per cent over the year. This compares with an increase of 122 people or 0.6 per cent in the year to June 2005.
- In the year to June 2005 natural increase (births minus deaths) accounted for an increase of 102 people while assumed net migration resulted in a gain of 20 people.
- Projections prepared by the Department indicate that by 2011 the expected population of Johnstone Shire will be between 19,500 and 19,900 people. By 2026 this is expected to change to between 19,300 and 20,900 people (Low and high series).
- The median age of Johnstone Shire's population is projected to increase by 8 years from a median age of 40 years in 2006 up to a median age of 48 years in 2026.
- Dwelling activity increased in Johnstone Shire in the year ending December 2006 with 132 approvals, 97.0 per cent of them for separate houses. Compared to 82 approvals in the previous year, these figures represent an increase of 61.0 per cent in dwelling activity.

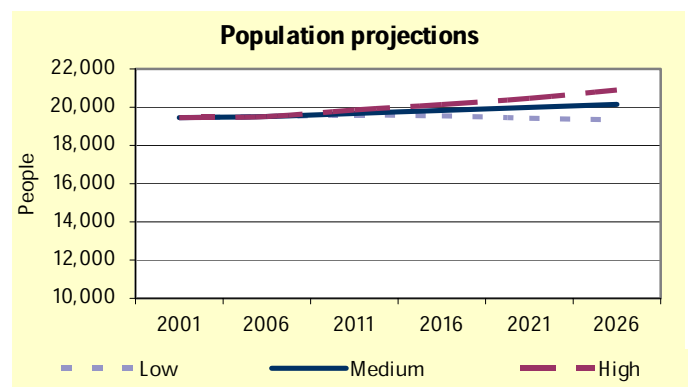

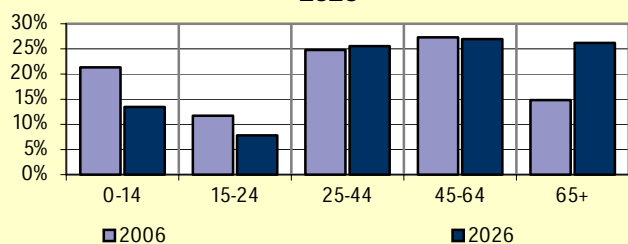

Age distribution, Johnstone Shire, 2006 and 2026

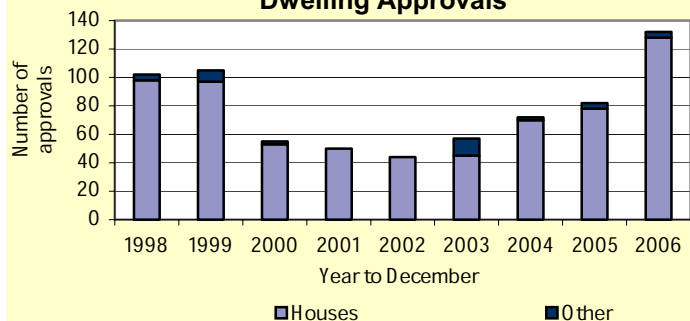
